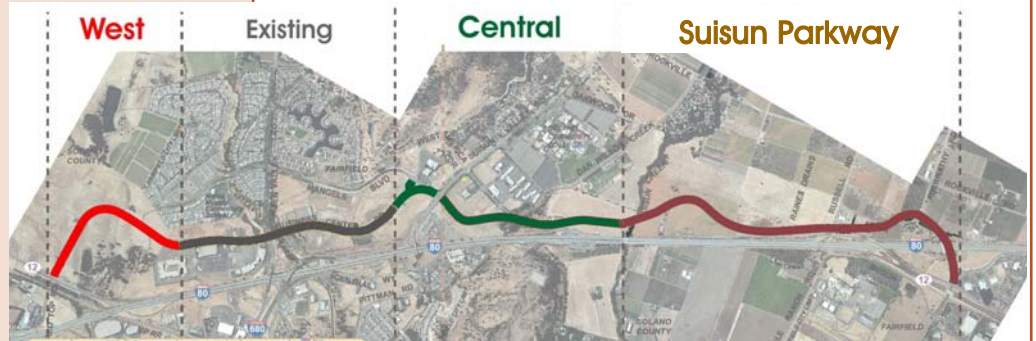


North Connector Project

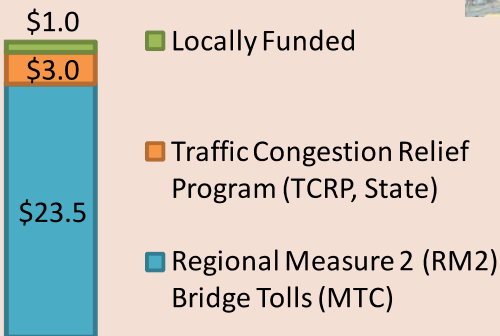
Suisun Parkway Segment

Project Scope

The Suisun Parkway segment of the North Connector project will build approximately 1.7 miles of new roadway parallel to I-80 from Abernathy Road to Suisun Valley Road, where it will connect with the new extension of the existing Business Center Drive. Travel will continue on Business Center Drive to Red Top Road at SR 12 West. The proposed project will be built in segments. STA is constructing the Suisun Parkway segment first, followed by the west segment, once funding is available and in coordination with the I-80/I-680/SR12 interchange improvements. The City of Fairfield, in conjunction with a private developer, is building the central segment now.

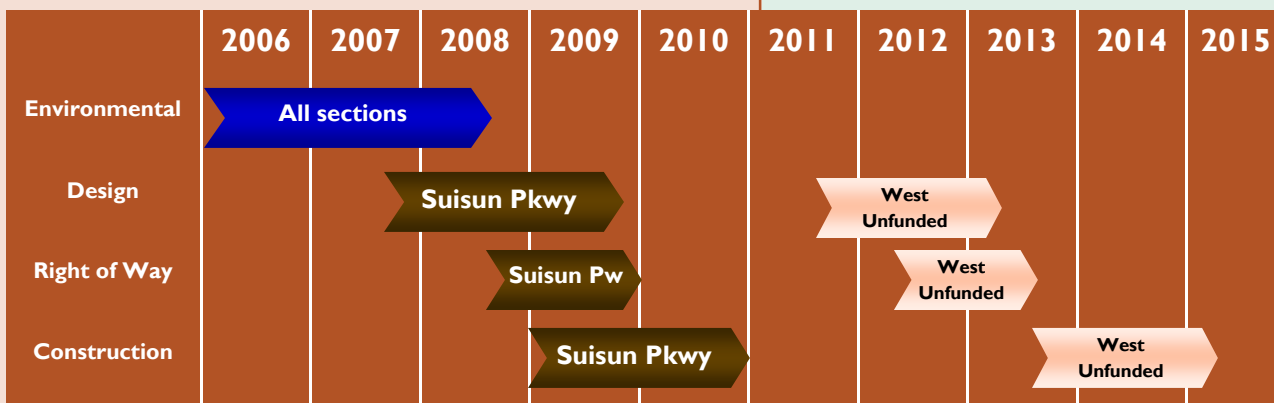


Cost (Suisun Parkway Segment)



\$ 27.5 M Total Project Cost

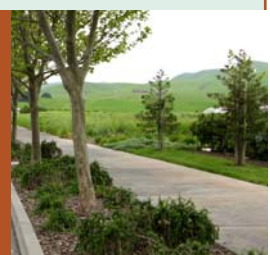

- Improve bicycle and pedestrian access through the Cordelia area.
