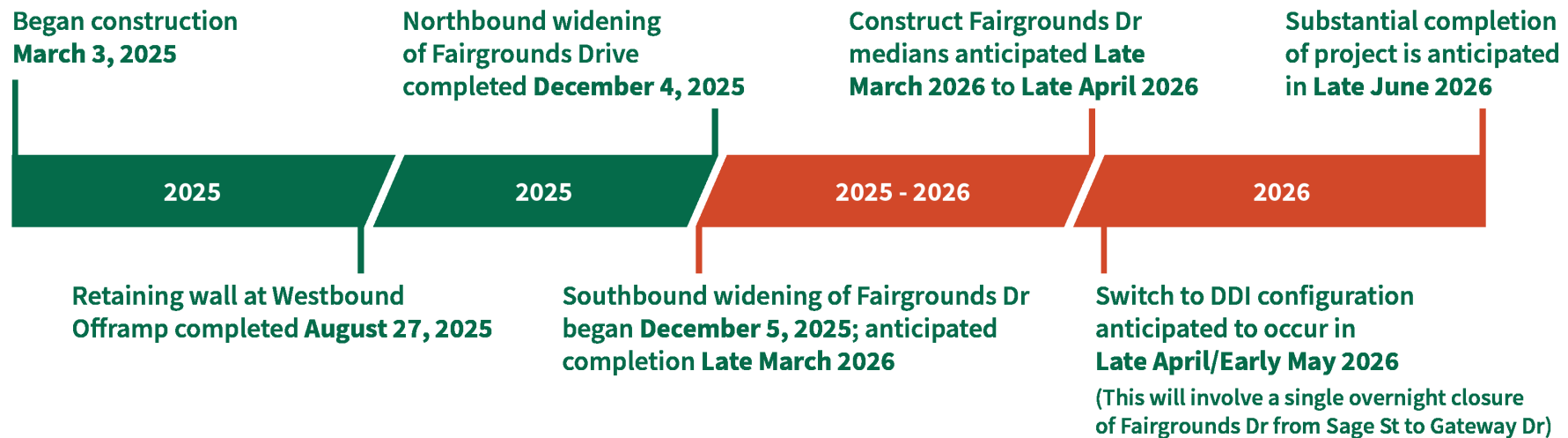


Overview of Construction

Expect Delays on Fairgrounds Drive; See Map with Alternate Routes!

Solano County - The Solano Transportation Authority (STA), in close coordination with its transportation partner, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), is continuing construction work on the new State Route 37 (SR 37)/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Project in Vallejo. The interchange improvement project will enhance motorist safety and improve bicycle and pedestrian access with construction of a new diverging diamond interchange. This is the first ever diverging diamond interchange (DDI) constructed in the Bay Area and only the second ever constructed on a major highway in California.

What to Expect During Initial Construction Work
Construction at SR 37 and Fairgrounds Drive started construction in April 2025. The site is near the Six Flags Discovery Kingdom Theme Park and the Solano County Fairgrounds. In May traffic in both directions were shifted to the west side of SR 37 and a temporary pedestrian walkway was constructed. Now, STA and Caltrans are moving forward with work to reconstruct the existing Fairgrounds Dr and widen the roadway to accommodate the upcoming Diverging Diamond Interchange.

The following construction related activities are slated for Monday - Friday during the weeks of January 26, 2026, and February 2, 2026.

Community members and motorists are advised to expect delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes during this time. (Please see map)

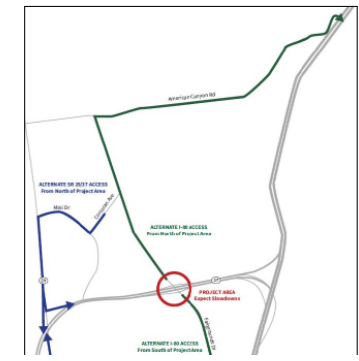
- Contractor to reduce northbound Fairgrounds Dr. from SR37 to Gateway Dr. down to one lane, day and night
- During this period, weather permitting, Fairgrounds Drive will be restriped utilizing single lane closures during daytime hours, 7:00am to 4:00pm.

Motorists should drive with caution in construction zones and expect travel delays. All work is weather dependent.

We appreciate the community's and motorists' cooperation and patience as important work to improve the safety and accessibility of this important project continues!

Project Overview

The Solano Transportation Authority, in partnership with the City of Vallejo, California Department of Transportation, Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), and Solano County, is leading construction on the State Route (SR) 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Improvements Project. This Project implements a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) design that will significantly improve traffic flow and safety while reducing congestion. At the end of the project, the interchange will be both safer and easier to access and navigate for motorists, transit riders, pedestrians, and cyclists.

Do you travel along Fairgrounds Drive under State Route 37?

This important intersection will soon be safer and easier for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists to travel through thanks to a new Diverging Diamond Interchange. The innovative design directs traffic through clear, signal-free left turns and reduces conflicts with oncoming traffic.

The redesigned interchange will also create new paths to make it quicker and safer to cross Fairgrounds Drive on bike and foot. The project is led by the Solano Transportation Authority, in partnership with Caltrans, the City of Vallejo, and Solano County.

When will it be done?

It's planned for completion and opening to traffic in the late spring/early summer.
