## A PROCLAMATION OF THE SOLANO TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY THANKING HARRY PRICE FOR HIS MANY EFFORTS ON BEHALF OF THE STA AND TRANSPORTATION ISSUES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD AND SOLANO COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, Harry Price in his capacity as Mayor for the City of Fairfield served as a representative on the Board of Directors for the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) from November 2005 to December 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, during 2011 and 2019 Harry Price served as the Chair of the STA; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure on the STA Board, he served on the STA's Executive Committee, Arterial, Highway, and Freeway Element and Transit Element Subcommittees for the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) which guided the implementation of multiple highway, roadway and transit projects, and as a member of the STA's Equity Task Force, which developed the initial STA equity policies as part of the CTP; and

**WHEREAS**, he effectively represented the STA on the governing Board for the Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Board (CCJPB) which included adding service to a new train station named the "Fairfield/Vacaville Hannigan Station" and serves the residents of Fairfield, Suisun City, Vacaville, Travis Air Force Base, and Solano County; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as a founding member of the Consolidated Transit Service Agency (CTSA) advisory committee, which provided guidance and recommendation on the development and implementation of Solano Mobility programs focused on providing mobility options for older adults, persons with disabilities, low income residents, and veterans; and

**WHEREAS**, he was an active supporter of the STA's Safe Routes to School Program (SR2S) and regularly participated in SR2S events including; Bike to School Day and International Walk to School Day in the Fairfield-Suisun School District; and

**WHEREAS**, during his term on the STA Board, Harry Price has been a diligent and proactive advocate for obtaining federal and state transportation funds for projects benefiting the City of Fairfield and Solano County, and on multiple times represented the STA in successful lobbying trips to Washington D.C. and Sacramento, that resulted in the STA landing federal and state funding for two phases of the I-80/I-680/SR 12 Interchange, the Fairfield/Vacaville/Hannigan Rail Station, the construction of the East Bound and design of the West Bound Cordelia Truck Scales, Solano Express Buses, and the construction of the I-80 Express Lanes project.
