Committee Member/Public Comments

Vice Mayor Terry Scott asked Brandon Thomson if Suisun Microtransit has experienced driver shortage issues. Brandon shared that the Suisun City Council made a decision to extend driver contracts for Suisun Microtransit school trippers to year-round to help with driver continuity and by providing job stability, this change has helped to alleviate the driver shortage.

Vice Mayor Terry Scott complimented Brian McLean on Vacaville City Coach's significant ridership gains over the last couple of years and asked what the operator did differently to accomplish this. Brian McLean responded that Vacaville City Coach's emphasis on customer service, reliability, and marketing have helped with their success.

2. Purpose and 6 Functional Areas of the MTC Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force

MTC Commissioner Jim Spering and Melanie Choy, Assistant Director of Funding and Programs at MTC provided an overview of the convening of the MTC Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force and the six functional areas that came out of the task force's work.

3. Solano Connected Mobility Implementation Plan Update

Ron Grassi, STA, provided an overview of the Solano Connected Mobility Implementation Plan and the future work to implement the recommendations from the MTC Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force.

Committee Member/Public Comments

MTC Commissioner Jim Spering asked if there have been discussions about implementing regional wayfinding across the six Solano operators. Ron Grassi responded that Solano County is currently second in line to participate in MTC's Regional Wayfinding Pilot Program, with Sonoma County currently in the implementation phase of this initiative. He continued by saying that the STA will make sure that lessons learned from the pilot in Sonoma will be applied as regional wayfinding is implemented in Solano.

Chair McConnell requested that the public outreach plan scheduled in spring 2024 for the Solano Connected Mobility Implementation Plan consider using public engagement strategies that are tailored to populations that are not tech-savvy, such as seniors, or who may not have access to tech, such as low-income individuals. He further emphasized the importance of this given that transit dependent riders tend to be seniors or low income individuals. Ron Grassi concurred with Chair McConnell's statement and shared that the first round of outreach for the effort dedicated resources to mailers and hardcopy surveys at community events, which saw a high response rate from these priority populations.

Mitch Mashburn, looks to focus on an overview of transit funding in connection to the transit fiscal cliff.

Ruben, brought up the importance of marketing, and making sure service is available to people.

Feinstain, want to look at evaluating programs to see if we are getting the biggest bang for buck and maximize resources.

Terry Scott, potential future topic, look at how resources could be pulled together to help with recruitment. Chair, concurred. DH said we are listing.

Mayor Moy, brought up safety on transit, and if its not safe they will not use it. Highlighted Vacaville City Coach. Also brought up clean transit.

Alma, asked what is the easiest way we have to understand how all our transportation works, is there a visual, how do we market, is there something already there? Mitch also commented, he knew people in community that we could tap and we should be reaching out to them and getting them on board. Alma said we should engage the people who are transit orient but also others whom may chose to use transit.

Brian, added, Solano Mobility Hub for the whole county, and then it moved down to transit agencies. In Vacaville, years ago they created a transit ambssedor program, and all agencies have created maps, and a transit map is not easiest to read, and what we could do is put people in the community who understand system- person to person environment and transfer the knowledge. Make it personal, call City Coach transit agency, its part of the customer service.
