#### Committee Member/Public Comments

Bob Berman, STA PAC Representative, inquired about the horizon year of the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP). Robert Guerrero, STA, responded that the horizon year will be consistent with MTC's Plan Bay Area 2050 in which projects that are identified and added in the plan include short term (next 5 years) and long-term (over the next 10 and 20 years) projects.

Mr. Berman also asked about the City of Benicia's planned active transportation safety improvements along on/off ramps and asked if there was any coordination planned with Caltrans on this work. In response, Neal Leary, Deputy Director/City Engineer from the City of Benicia, clarified that for project areas that are in Caltrans right-of-way, which may include on/off ramps, they plan to closely coordinate and partner with Caltrans to implement safety improvements to active transportation facilities.

Mr. Berman asked the City of Fairfield which of the Active Transportation Priority Projects they presented supported Priority Development Areas (PDAs). Jason Riley, Assistant City Engineer for the City of Fairfield, said that two priority of their active transportation projects support PDAs, which include the Travis Safe Routes to School & Transit Trail Project that serves the Northeast Fairfield PDA, and the Linear Park Node 4 Trail Project that serves the North Texas PDA.

Erin Morris, Planning Director Representative, inquired about the project status of Nelson Road Trail Extension. Mr. Riley noted that the project was included the city's Capital Improvement Plan within the 5–10-year planning horizon and the city plans on coordinating with the City of Vacaville and the unincorporated County to move the project forward.

Dave Belef, STA SR2S Representative asked the City of Vallejo the project location for the Mare Island Causeway Bike and Pedestrian Access Project. Mark Helmbrecht, Transportation Program Superintendent for the City of Vallejo, said that the project encompasses the ramp coming from the Waterfront Promenade up to Mare Island Causeway. Mr. Helmbrecht added that the city has been coordinating with MTC for technical support for engineering and design that will enhance and improve transportation connections to the Mare Island Causeway.

Mr. Berman inquired about the project status of the Rockville Crossing Project. Riley Martinson, Senior Civil Engineer for County of Solano, reported that the project is currently in the design phase. He also added that the project will be moved forward for implementation once it is approved by the Solano County Board of Supervisors around Spring of 2024.

**C. Draft CTP Active Transportation Element Goals and Objectives**

Josh Pilachowski, DKS, introduced the draft CTP Active Transportation Committee Goals and Objectives in preparation of the upcoming ATC meeting where the topic will return for the committee's discussion and feedback.

Committee Member/Public Comments

Bob Berman, STA PAC Representative, requested STA staff to consider the inclusion of local and regional trails under the goals being considered for the Active Transportation Element. Dave Belef, STA SR2S Representative, concurred with Mr. Berman and additionally emphasized the importance of Quality of Life and Environmental Stewardship benefits of local and regional trails.

Josh Pilachowski, DKS, responded that access to regional trails is already an existing goal that is captured in the 2020 Active Transportation Plan (ATP) and will likely be carried forward in the CTP AT element update. Mr. Pilachowski further added that a metric that was used for the Project Evaluation Criteria was connectivity to the Solano Countywide Regional Trail Network.

## **7. ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION**

Dave Belef, STA SR2S Representative, brought up the ongoing STA Safe Routes to School Plan Update and asked to ensure the incorporation of this plan into the Active Transportation Element. Mr. Belef also expressed his support in advancing projects that reduce vehicle miles traveled (VMT), reduce congestion across all communities, and increase the safety of active transportation users.

Bob Berman, STA PAC Representative, suggested to STA staff to continue to partner and coordinate with regional trail groups to advance overlapping project priorities. STA noted his comment.

Councilmember Jim Ernest emphasized his support for active transportation facilities that prioritize safety and usage for all ages and abilities.

Councilmember Terry Scott expressed his gratitude for the Member Agency Priority Project Presentations and emphasized the importance of continued partnership and coordination to seek grant funding and implement the projects. Chair Hernandez concurred with this comment and remarked that the active transportation element provides a great opportunity to guide STA staff in identifying projects that are multijurisdictional and provide multi-benefits to be competitive for grant funding.
