Purpose & Needs

Purpose

The State Route 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Project will address issues of accessibility, mobility, roadway safety, and congestion relief for motorists, transit riders, bicyclists, and pedestrians in a manner that stimulates economic vitality,



promotes environmental sustainability and increases quality of life for Vallejo residents by incorporating a Diverging Diamond Interchange design configuration.

Needs

- Lack of dedicated bicycle lanes that are safe to the community
- Unsafe pedestrian sidewalks and intersection crossings that are not Americans with Disabilities Act compliant
- Longer transit connectivity between local and regional services
- Extensive traffic delays on the eastbound/westbound approach of the State Route 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange
- Greater exposure to potential vehicle accidents due to multiple conflict points arising from the existing interchange configuration
- The surrounding community is exposed disproportionately to harmful pollutants emanating from the stop and go traffic
- Lack of transportation investment in the surrounding disadvantaged communities
- Ineffective operational flow of the tight diamond interchange configuration with additional interchange traffic anticipated
- Stagnant economic and housing activities in the project area
