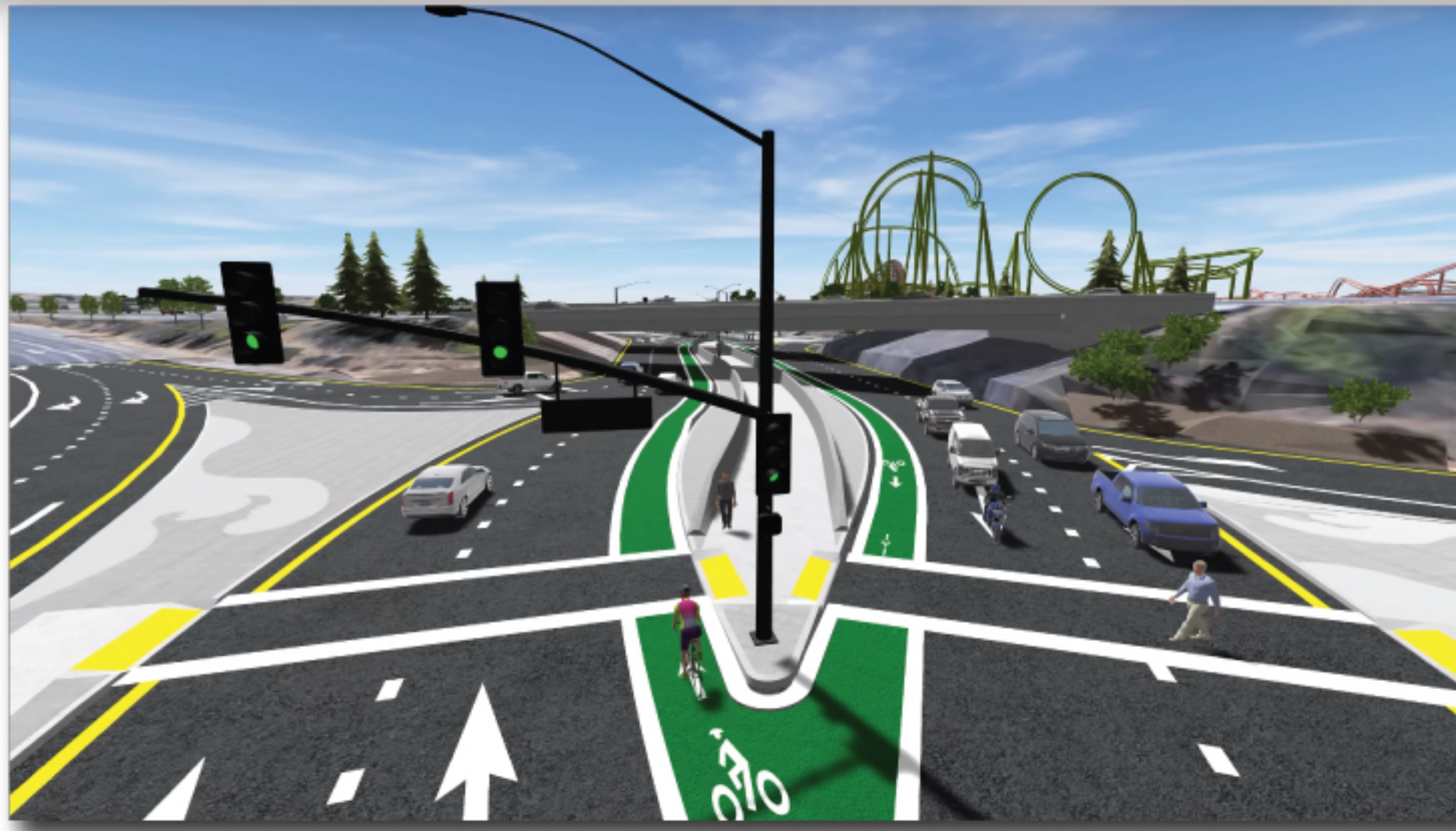


State Route 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Project



Active Transportation Facilities Bike & Pedestrian



- Increases roadway safety for all active transportation users
- Reduces conflict points between bike/pedestrian and vehicle roadway traffic
- Installs clearly delineated 6-foot wide Class II bike lanes with visible green lane pavement markings along Fairgrounds Drive in both directions within the project area
- Constructs a 12-foot wide Class I concrete barrier protected median to enhance pedestrian and bike safety
- Signalizes and shortens pedestrian on/off ramp intersection crossings
- Signalizes Fairgrounds Drive/Sage Street intersection crossing
- Creates 10-foot wide crosswalks



- Upgrades all curb ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act standards
- Prohibits right turn on red movements at the Fairgrounds Drive/Sage Street intersection to increase pedestrian safety
- Provides adequate sight distance for vehicles turning at signalized intersections to observe bike/pedestrian traffic crossings
- All active transportation facilities have been designed to be consistent with Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Local, and State standards
