State Route 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Project



Transit Improvements

- Consolidates the regional SolanoExpress Red Line eastbound and westbound bus stops to a new single location
- The new bus stop will be safer to transit passengers as it has its own dedicated lane away from general vehicle traffic along Fairgrounds Drive
- The consolidated location will have two bus bays to accommodate two coach buses at the same time
- The consolidated bus stop shortens the walking transfer distance between the local and regional bus services on Fairgrounds Drive
- Transit passengers going to Six Flags will have a safer intersection crossing at Fairgrounds Drive & Sage Street, as well as shorter walking distance
- The new bus stop will be Americans with Disabilities
 Act compliant
- SolanoExpress Red Line buses will be able to safely and efficiently traverse the diverging diamond interchange to get onto either eastbound or westbound State Route 37
- The consolidated bus stop will just be a block away from the future Fairgrounds Drive Mobility Hub Project being developed by the County of Solano
- The consolidated bus station and future mobility hub will support the needed transit service on State Route 37 from City of Vallejo to employment and transit hub destinations either in Marin or Sonoma counties





Solano County Mobility Hub

- Over 280 Park-and-Ride Stalls within walking distance of both local and regional transit
- Onsite Local Transit Hub with designated pick-up/drop-off and rideshare zones
- 15 New EV Charging Stations, expandable to accommodate up to 55 in the future
