1. State Highway Operation and Project Program (SHOPP)

Summary of Committee Member Comments:

Committee members concurred that current SR113 roadway conditions were dangerous and expressed the importance of prioritizing the SR113 SHOPP project that would rehabilitate the roadway. Once the SHOPP projects commence for the corridor, traffic conditions will be temporarily impacted; however, there will be extensive outreach to the public in advance so that users can plan accordingly and anticipate traffic delays if they utilize the corridor.

Committee members requested further clarification on the purpose of the SR113 Study and the upcoming SHOPP projects. In response, STA staff commented that the SR113 SHOPP projects will be addressing the immediate infrastructure needs of the roadway, with the Study will be tackling long-range planning for SR113, which will be looking to establish a baseline of current conditions and exploring alternative alignments on SR113.

There was discussion on the need to service transit on the SR113, and STA staff further explained that due to the state's climate goals, roadway expansion is challenging to construct if there is no transit or Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program to mitigate the increase in VMT. Therefore, if SR113 were to be expanded, transit or alternative TDM programs would have to be implemented to complete the project.
