



## Call for Projects for the Transportation Development Act Article 3 (TDA-3) Funds

The Solano Transportation Authority is accepting grant applications for bicycle and pedestrian projects through the TDA-3 Program. The deadline for application submittals is June 30, 2026. This is part of a coordinated call for projects for One Bay Area Grant Cycle 4 (OBAG 4), CARE, and TFCA 40% Fund Program discretionary funds.

### **Total Funding Available:**

Solano Transportation Authority (STA) annual TDA-3 discretionary funds capacity is estimated to be about \$500,000 to fund bicycle, pedestrian, and traffic calming projects consistent with [MTC's TDA-3 guidelines](#).

As part of this Call for Projects, STA staff will consider a multi-year allocation of funds of up to 4 years as part of the Coordinated Call for Projects with the OBAG 4, CARE, and TFCA 40% Fund Program. The TDA-3 funding estimate over the next four years is estimated to be close to 2 million dollars.

### **Eligible Recipients:**

Public agencies located in the seven Solano cities and the unincorporated County of Solano.

### **Project Completion:**

Projects must be completed within three fiscal years after funding has been allocated.

### **Presentation to the STA Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BAC/PAC):**

Project sponsors are required to present their project proposals at the in-person Joint BAC/PAC meeting scheduled for **September 3, 2026, from 6:00-7:30 p.m.**, at the STA Building located at 423 Main Street, Suisun City, CA 94585.

As part of the TDA-3 allocation process, the STA BAC/PAC reviews project proposals and forwards a joint funding recommendation to the STA TAC and STA Board for approval.

If awarded funding, grant recipients may be requested to provide future project delivery status updates to STA staff and the STA BAC/PAC.



### **How to Submit an Application:**

Submit an application package with the following:

- **Cover Letter** that summarizes the project proposal and total funding request
- **Application Form** – included as Attachment A

Completed applications are due by 5:00 PM on **June 30, 2026** and can be submitted via email to Dulce Jimenez, Assistant Planner, at [djimenez@sta.ca.gov](mailto:djimenez@sta.ca.gov). Interested applicants are highly encouraged to consult with STA staff before applying to determine their project eligibility.
