



Call for Projects for the Bay Area Air District Transportation Fund for Clean Air 40% Fund Program

The Solano Transportation Authority is accepting grant applications for bicycle and pedestrian projects and other clean air-eligible projects. The deadline for application submittals is June 30, 2026. This is part of a coordinated call for projects for One Bay Area Grant Cycle 4 (OBAG 4), CARE, and TDA-3 discretionary funds.

Total Funding Available:

There is **1 million dollars** in funding available for bicycle and pedestrian projects, smart growth/traffic calming projects, and other clean air projects consistent with [TFCA 40% Fund Program Guidelines](#). Active transportation projects will be prioritized for funding.

As part of this Call for Projects, STA staff will be developing a funding plan for up to 4 years as part of the Coordinated Call for Projects with the OBAG 4, CARE, and TDA-3 STA discretionary funds.

Eligible Recipients:

Public agencies within the Bay Area Air District basin, which include the cities of Benicia, Fairfield, Suisun City, Vallejo, and the southwestern unincorporated portion of Solano County.

Project Completion:

Projects must be completed within two years after a funding agreement has been executed between the STA and Grant Recipient.

Cost Effectiveness Requirements:

Projects recommended for TFCA funding will need to meet cost-effectiveness standards set by the Bay Area Air District. The cost-effectiveness calculations are conducted by STA staff and will be based on the project information provided via the application submittal.

Project Delivery Updates from Grant Recipients:

Grant Recipients will be requested to provide project delivery status updates to STA staff through Interim Project Reports while the project is ongoing. The Grant Recipient must submit a Final Project Report upon completion of the project.



How to Submit an Application:

Submit an application package with the following:

- **Cover Letter** that summarizes the project proposal and total funding request
- **Application Form** – included as Attachment A

Completed applications are due by 5:00 PM on **June 30, 2026** and can be submitted via email to Dulce Jimenez, Assistant Planner, at djimenez@sta.ca.gov. Interested applicants are highly encouraged to consult with STA staff before applying to determine their project eligibility.

FY 2026-27 TFCA 40% Fund Program Call for Projects Schedule:

- **Release the Call for Projects and Application Package** — May 13, 2026
- **Deadline for Applications** — June 30, 2026
- **Draft Project Recommendations to the STA TAC** — September 30, 2026
- **Draft Project Recommendations to the STA Board** — October 14, 2026
- **Funding Agreements*** will be sent out in December 2026

Grant recipients approved for TFCA funding will need to execute a funding agreement once the Bay Area Air District staff have reviewed and approved FYE 2027 project submittals.
