2. CONFIRM QUORUM

Quorum was confirmed.

3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

On a motion from Mike Segala, and a second from Mick Weninger, the BAC unanimously approved the agenda.

4. OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

BAC members commented that with the new bike lockers coming in to the train depot, the old bike lockers needed a home. BAC members suggested that they be placed in the parking lot across from the depot, or perhaps at the mall. No consensus was reached at this time, but it was determined that further discussion would commence via other means of communication.

5. CONSENT CALENDAR

A. Recommendation:

Approve STA BAC Meeting Minutes of July 7, 2016.

On a motion by Barbara Wood, and a second by James Fisk, the BAC approved the minutes of July 7, 2016. Lori Wilson Abstained (6 Ayes, 2 Absent) (Lori Wilson arrived after this item was voted on).

6. ACTION NON - FINANCIAL

A. One Bay Area Grant (OBAG) Cycle 2 Project Selection

Recommendation:

1. Select the BAC's highest priority bicycle infrastructure project for which OBAG 2 funding is requested.

2. Authorize appointed BAC representative to carry that request to STA Board workshop on October 12, 2016.

On a motion by Mike Segala, and a second by Barbara Wood, the BAC unanimously approved the recommendation, and selected Nancy Lund, Barbara Wood and Mike Segala to attend the STA Board Workshop on October 12, 2016 (7 Ayes, 1 Absent).

7. INFORMATIONAL DISCUSSION

A. Bike Route Signage – Plan for the I-80/I-680/SR12 Interchange

Recommendation:

Approve the bike route signage plan for the I-80/I-680/SR-12 Interchange project as shown in Attachment A.

On a motion by Barbara Wood, and a second by Mike Segala, the BAC unanimously approved the recommendation to place bike route signage along the I-80/I-680/SR12 Interchange where appropriate (7 Ayes, 1 Absent).

8. INFORMATIONAL - DISCUSSION

A. Countywide Bike Plan Update

Drew Hart quickly presented due to a constraint on time, the Countywide Bike Plan Update. He stated that STA maintains both the Countywide Bicycle Transportation Plan and the Countywide Pedestrian Transportation Plan, and that both of these plans were adopted in 2012. Mr. Hart highlighted that with the consensus brought forward of not only the BAC members, but also agency staff, regarding the need to update the Countywide Bike Plans, the STA Board approved the \$250,000 request. Mr. Hart also noted that four cities (Rio Vista, Dixon, Suisun City, and Vallejo) have also expressed an interest in creating city-specific plans. These plans would partially be funded with that initial allotment. He noted that STA would meet with the cities in the coming weeks to identify their goals and objectives for these plans and assist in creating strategic layouts that would work not only with the cities goals, but also as a whole throughout the County of Solano.

Mr. Hart concluded the update noting that STA staff will receive training through UC Berkeley for four days in November for these bike plans, and to educate staff on the best practices and requirements for not only the bicycle plans in the state, but also to how best apply them to each cities individual needs.

9. INFORMATIONAL - NO DISCUSSION

A. Reports and Updates from Staff

Drew hart provided reports and updates for staff in the packet. This is a no discussion item where Committee members and the public may submit comments and questions to staff for more information.

RE: Solano Bike Map and Wayfinding Signage

Background:

For over a decade the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) has developed a bike map for Solano County. This map serves as the only bike map for Solano County as individual cities do not maintain a bike map for public use.

The bike map gets minor updates each year by STA staff. New updates are printed in time for Bike to Work Day in May. The funds that cover these costs come from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD). Historically, the other air district, Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (YSAQMD) has contributed funds for the map.

In January 2016, the STA BAC approved a strategy to peruse funding for the purpose of redesigning the bike map and producing more wayfinding signs. Since that time, STA staff successfully secured \$100,000 for a combined effort to redesign the bike map and install wayfinding signs. This funding came from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (\$60,000) and the Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (\$40,000).

Discussion:

The focus of these funds continue to be on opportunities to increase cycling in Solano County. While STA staff still plans to redesign the overall map of bikeways in the county, the need for a promotional effort continues to grow.

STA staff proposes a more targeted map containing the best rides in Solano County, showcasing the natural assets and infrastructure investments enjoyed by cyclists in the area. Benefits to this approach include a faster production time, smaller budget, and the flexibility to have both a comprehensive map and a promotional piece.

The guidelines of the proposed map will mirror those previously discussed with the BAC including the following:

- Top Ten rides in Solano County as a way to highlight and promote cycling in the area
- Simpler design focusing on what is necessary for the end user
- Smaller printed version of the map
- Mobile friendly

The map and the signage will work together to promote cycling in Solano County. The map will be printed and distributed as part of Bike to Work Day, Solano Mobility campaigns, local community events, and will be placed at transportation centers. The map will also be featured on our website.

An effort of this kind will require unique skills in integrating cartography, graphic design, and brand messaging. STA staff will seek Board approval in December to release a Request for Proposal (RFP) from interested and qualified firms early in 2017.

Fiscal Impact:

Release an RFP for up to \$30,000 for design services funded by the air districts.

Recommendation:

Forward a recommendation to the STA TAC and STA Board to approve the release of an RFP for design services for the Top Ten Rides in Solano County Map of the amount not to exceed \$30,000.

RE: Update on One Bay Area Grant Cycle 2 (OBAG 2) Progress

Background:

The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for preparing the Bay Area's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). This document is known as Plan Bay Area. The RTP assigns funds for various purposes including some that are programmed by the Congestion Management Agencies (CMAs) such the STA. One of the key funding programs is the One Bay Area Grant (OBAG). MTC has now set out policies and established funding amounts for the second cycle of OBAG. This covers Fiscal Years (FYs) 2017-18 through 2022-23.

Discussion:

At its meeting of September 14, 2016, the STA Board issued a Call for Projects for OBAG 2 funds. The Call for Projects is for \$4,646,003 of CMAQ funds with funds to be distributed on a competitive basis, using the criteria approved by the Board at the same time.

The Call for Projects is open for eight weeks – from September 14th through November 18, 2016.

The purpose of the October 12 workshop and Board meeting agenda item was to allow members of the general public and the STA advisory committees to provide input to the STA Board regarding what are their recommended priorities for OBAG 2 funding. The meetings also provide an opportunity for STA board members to ask questions of project advocates. No action was taken at that time.

The following is a list of the committees and the projects they recommended for funding:

Fiscal Impact:

Projects selected as a result of the Call for Projects are then eligible to receive funding. There is an 11.47 % non-Federal match required for OBAG 2 projects and programs.

RE: Progress on I-80/I-680/SR 12 Interchange

Background:

Since 2001, STA staff has been working with project consultants, Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to complete improvements to the I-80/I-680/SR12 Interchange Complex. As it nears the final construction of the current package, STA staff provides the Bicycle Advisory Committee a status update.

Discussion:

Upon the request from the STA Board, consultants and STA staff have worked with Fairfield staff to further investigate bike movements at the intersection of Green Valley Rd and Business Center Drive. Of most concern was the turning movement by cyclists moving northbound on Green Valley Rd, turning westbound on Business Center drive to eventually access the Class I bike path connecting to SR 12 (Jameson Canyon) to Napa. After reviewing a number of design options, consultants are drawing up designs for a protected intersection. See Attachment A for a preliminary sketch.

STA staff will present more detail and answer questions at the meeting.

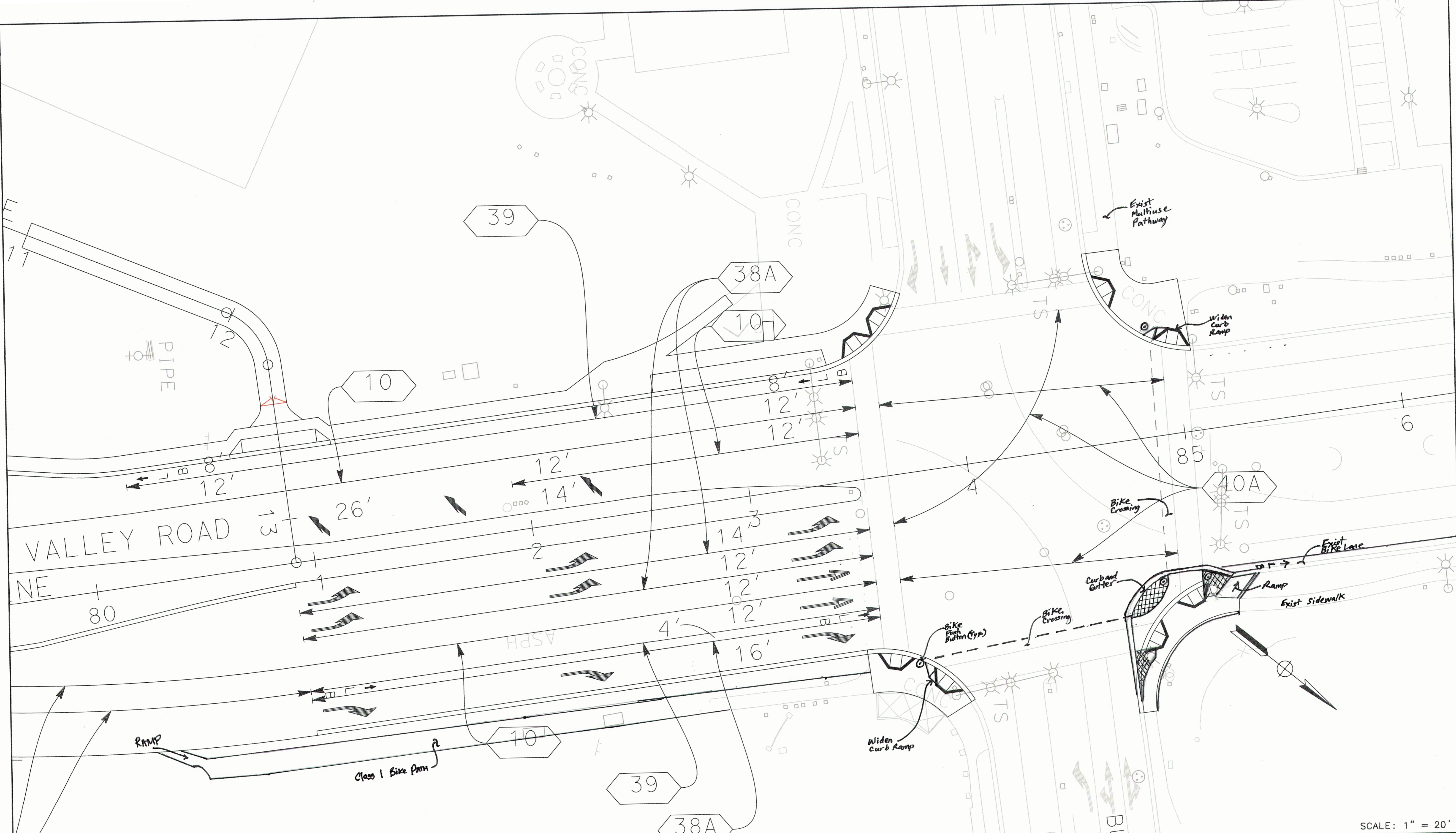
Fiscal Impact:

RE: Report on Suisun City Rail-Volution Tour

Background:

Rail-Volution is a professional organization which brings transportation professionals, elected officials, and agency staff together to discuss best practices and share ideas and frustrations about building livable communities with transit. The annual conference rotates locations annually. San Francisco hosted the 2016 national Rail-Volution conference in October.

Offered as part of the conference are mobile workshops which are opportunities for attendees to visit nearby locations to see and learn from real life examples.

Discussion:

STA staff worked with Suisun City staff to host a mobile workshop in Suisun City. The focus of the workshop was the redevelopment of Suisun City's waterfront and quality public transit in the suburbs. Seventeen attendees from across the country and Canada used six modes of transportation during the mobile workshop.

Background:

The Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) often hears about an assortment of bicycle related issues around the county and region. Some of these issues are of high importance and receive a portion of the agenda in the form of discussion items or presentations. Other issues are more appropriate to briefly report on in the form of updates. Below is a list of topics and brief updates.

Active Transportation Program (ATP)

ATP is a statewide funding program that aims to build bike/ped facilities that will see people getting out of their cars and using active transportation more often. In Cycle 3, approximately \$120 million is available at the statewide level, and \$20 million at the regional level. STA staff offered help to the three applications which were submitted on June 15, 2016. The three applications submitted from Solano County agencies are below:

- Fairfield – East Tabor Avenue
- Vallejo – Bay Trail – Vine Trail
- Suisun City – McCoy Creek Trail Extension

At the time of this writing, the recommendations for statewide awards have not been announced. Regional awards are expected to be announced mid-November.

Section 1. Meetings/Attendance (Bylaws)

Absence after contacting staff is considered a ‘contacted absence.’ Contacted absences and un-contacted absences shall be documented in the minutes of each meeting. If a BAC member has missed a combination of four contacted and un-contacted absences in any one-year period, he or she will be sent a written notice of intent to declare the position vacant. If there is no adequate response before or at the next scheduled meeting, and based upon a recommendation from the BAC, the position may be declared vacant by the STA Board.
